

CityPASS New York Attractions:

New York CityPASS tickets can be a great option for traveling with children of any age. CityPASS tickets provide a significant cost savings on regular admission tickets for children starting at age 6. Children under age 6 may be eligible for free or discounted admission at some attractions (as seen below); however, some attractions may require you to stand in the main ticket line to secure a free/discounted child's ticket—a step you may be able to skip by having youth CityPASS tickets.

- The Empire State Building - Actual admission may vary (\$53.25-\$54.75) depending on date of visit.

- American Museum of Natural History - Ages 2-5, \$16; 1 & under, free
- The Metropolitan Museum of Art - Ages 5 & under, free
- Top of the Rock Observation Deck - Ages 5 & under, free
- Guggenheim Museum - Ages 5 & under, free
- Statue of Liberty & Ellis Island - Ages 4-5, \$9; 3 & under, free
- Circle Line Sightseeing Cruises - Ages 3-5, \$25; 2 & under, free
- 9/11 Memorial & Museum - Ages 13-17, \$20; Ages 7-12, \$15; Ages 6 & under, free
- Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum - Ages 3-5, \$17; 2 & under, free
